### **Coordinator's Report**

Archer Park Rail Museum was pleased to host a visit from the Michael Klug, Queensland Rail Chairman, the COO and Board members. It was wonderful to receive positive feedback from the members of the board and know that they enjoyed their short visit to the Museum.

A Tram Crew and Volunteer Open Day will be held on Sunday, 9 October 2016, 12:30 to 2:00pm. We are seeking people to become tram crew and museum volunteers. This is open for both men and women; tea/coffee and bickies will be provided.

The Bluebirds United Sports Club on Richardson Road has been booked for our Christmas party which will be held on Saturday 3 December, sitting down at 1:00pm. We are pleased to advise that NEATO has renewed its contract with Archer Park. For the next 6 months we will have the group here for 4 days a week.

They have now completed the rock block retainer wall around the coke and coal piles, a major improvement. They are again working on CWM21 coach; with all windows and catches installed they are now working on the roof as well as general maintenance and gardens.

This work is a major contribution to the operational needs of the station and we express our appreciation to NEATO and their workers.

We have had a busy 2 months with several school and seniors groups visiting for tours as well as a venue hire. Our venue hire is becoming quite popular for weddings, parties and even training groups. The Family Fun Day on 28 August saw three hundred and seventy-six people visit the station, a little down on previous Family Fun Days but this always happens when there are other events in Rockhampton at the same time.

An annual track inspection was carried out last month by the Coordinator and the Track Supervisor, this was undertaken to see what maintenance work needs to be prioritized for the October/November track work.

### **Rollingstock Supervisor's Report**

The Purrey Steam Tram has been operating well but still has to have the new steam pressure gauge installed. The tram crew are keeping a watchful eye on the refractory cement in the fire box as some of the cement has broken away. This will be replaced during the end of year shut down.

The Billard Loco tractor has had some problems with air leaks and the foot brake not working. RRC fitters have adjusted the brakes and disconnected the hose bag where a leak was found. The hose bag is not required on the loco as it is never used. A couple of more air leaks have still to be repaired but at the moment do not stop the loco from working. We are also still having some issues with the float and the fitters continue to try to get to the bottom of the problem.
