

QR 1614 English Electric

The 1600 class locomotives were built by the English Electric Company (Australia), Rocklea, Brisbane. The eighteen diesel electric locomotives of this class went into service with Queensland Government Railways in 1963 and were withdrawn from service in 1991.

The 1600 class locomotives worked on branch lines throughout the state hauling goods and passenger services. No 1614 worked through Archer Park Railway Station during its working life and is currently on loan from the Australian Railway Historical Society (Queensland).
