Coordinator's Report

Christmas Party: The Member's Christmas Party is to be held at Archer Park Rail Museum on Saturday 20 November 2021 starting at midday. There will be no charge for the party, but you are asked to bring a plate, and the "Friends" will also supply food.

Halloween Event: Lana and Kerrie organised the Halloween event on Sunday 31 October 2021. The kids had pin the tail on the Werewolf, throw the ring over the witches hat, scavenger hunt and costume parade. Kerrie had a photo booth and lots of photos were taken. The kids had a great day and we had 89 visitors attend on Sunday 31 October 2021. We will put this on our calendar as an annual event. Thanks to Lana and Kerrie and Merrill for a very successful day.

End of Year Maintenance on Tram: The end of year boiler inspection and non-destructive testing (ultrasound) is scheduled to commence on Wednesday 1 December 2021. We will need our usual volunteers to disassemble the tram in preparation (take off all the covers, etc.) for the work. At this time we will see the wear and tear on the boiler as it gets close to needing a replacement.

After the inspection, the RRC will come in and do their usual end of year maintenance on all our operational rollingstock.

Visitor Numbers: Our numbers through the door in August were very low compared to the previous 2 years, despite the August Family Fun Day. September did improve to be more than 2019 but lower than 2020. We are still being affected by Covid events in other parts of the state and country.

October Family Fun Day: Unfortunately our October Family Fun Day was unsuccessful with only 89 visitors, including 13 stall holders. There were several reasons for this but the main one being that our banners at Colts and PCYC were deliberately covered up by the operators of Family Fun Fair that was held at Stapleton park. There were several other big events including the Rocky River Festival.

In the future, we will appoint some members to keep an eye on our banners and let us know if there are any impediments to our information getting to the community.

Qld Gallery and Museum Standards Review Program: The program is still on hold, but we hope to get going again either in November or early 2022. This program is providing support to the museum to improve its collection management policy and procedures and help train staff on how to manage the collection. The next part of the program is to have a site visit from 2 mentors and the Qld Gallery and Museum officer.

Volunteers: We are close to starting the Work for the Dole program again with both Max Solutions and Community Solutions. This program will provide extra help to maintain the facility and yards, which will be a huge help. Over the last year, we have generally only had Richard Parker and John Kennedy doing

mowing and whipper-snipping, with the Fitzroy River Lions coming in a couple of times to assist when they were able.
