2025 Plans & Events Update

February Family Fun Day

Sunday 23 February 2025 saw the first family fun day for 2025. There were no major issues on the day and the tram was available all day to visitors. We had 244 visitors through the door – which is fantastic considering the February Family Fun Day is usually our quiet one.

April School Holiday Specials

On Wednesday 9 April and Wednesday 16 April we had our first lot of school holiday specials for the 2025 year. Over both Wednesdays we

had 166 visitors to Archer Park Rail Museum – which all enjoyed their visits. We are hoping the next lot of school holidays in July will be just as successful and advertisement for this will commence at the end of May.

We are glad to announce that Aurizon will be attending the July school holiday specials – they will be talking to parents and children about the risks associated with level crossings in acknowledgement of National Rail Safety Week activities.

ANZAC Family Fun Day

The April Family Fun Day at the end of April saw Archer Park Rail Museum acknowledge our war veterans, past and present. The majority of APRM members have either served with the Australian Armed Services or have had family members or friends serve. This year also marked the 110th anniversary of the Gallipoli landings in Türkiye and the 80th anniversary of the conclusion of WWII.

Our Family Fun Day was held in conjunction with the Central Queensland Military Museum (across the carpark from the APRM complex) with the CQMM happy to be on board with the event.

Just before 11am, the Last Post was played out across the museum complex with all management, volunteers and public falling silent. We stood shoulder to shoulder and reflected upon the service of those who have served, currently serving and to those who never came home, especially those who worked with the Australian Railways or via personal connection. We also acknowledge the Rail Preservation Society of Queensland Inc. and the Member for Rockhampton, Donna Kirkland for their attendance on the morning.

We are happy to report that 191 visitors passed through the door and overall, it was a very successful morning. There are a couple of photographs from the morning attached to the back of the newsletter as well.

Upcoming Events:

June and July will be a busy couple of months for the APRM team. At the end of June will be

the Heroes v Villains Family Fun Day which we hope to see many volunteers on hand that day and advertising for the event has already commenced. Management and volunteers are welcome to come dressed up in costume on the day.

Our school holiday specials will continue through the July school holidays. Also, management is in the early stages of planning for the August Family Fun Day which once again will be the Teddies on the Tram (which was quite successful in 2024) and will allow for management, volunteers and the public to go back to their childhood days.

This year we are also opening on the Rockhampton Show Holiday on Thursday 12 June 2025. It will be run like a school holidays special Wednesday – where entry fees are \$6 per person.

Visitors Numbers & Venue Hire

Bayview Tower Yeppoon returned to APRM back in March after the summer hiatus. They have already informed us prior to the commencement of their tours in March of the dates they will be attending APRM.

We also have had an independent venue hire back at the end of March and have several more booked throughout 2025. The independent venue hire ran smoothly – and we received fantastic feedback from them.

Visitor numbers for 2024/2025 were up by 869 people compared to the 2023/2024 period. We are hoping the 2025/2026 will just be as successful. We acknowledge that the additional visitors in 2024-2025 was due to the 125th anniversary back in November 2024.

Track & Rollingstock Report

We are very grateful to Clermont Open Cut Mine, Glencore and Clermont Haulage for the donation of 14 tonne of coal and delivery to our storage site out at the Heritage Village in late February. Without the coal, we would not be able to operate the Tram. The coal will keep us going for the next 3 to 4 years. We also are grateful to ASL Global for supplying us with more coke to use in the tram.

Since the beginning of the year, we have had a steady stream of visitors riding on the Purrey Steam Tram. For the first three operational months of 2025, we have had 820 visitors ride the tram. Don't forget the tram operates every Sunday between February and November excluding Easter Sunday and unplanned closures.

During late March and into early April, the track maintenance team lead by John Kennedy replaced a section of rail within Platform Road as part of the rail was starting to heavily corrode. It was repaired within a couple of weeks and without the hard work and dedication of the team – this wouldn't have been able to happen.
